Steve Daly also ran, same venue, 2 rounds of 60m recording 8.23s twice again a PB, Steve is also a M50.

Mark McAllister also ran at the London Indoor Games and ran 26.05 in the 200m Saturday and two rounds of 60m today 7.86 then improved in second round with 7.81 so slowly chipping away at those times! Mark is still M45 but will be M50 Feb 10th. There are a few of us that have entered the Indoor British Masters at Lee Valley on 5/6 March so watch this space!"
