Dan Bradley achieved selection for the England Masters XC team at the prestigious home international XC in Dublin.

Helen Gaunt was selected for England Masters at the Bristol 10k (35.41) and was fastest W40 at the London Marathon in 2.39.10 and 4th woman outside of elites.

Grazia Manzotti is the leading W50 race walker in the uk, holding national records and titles.

Ben Reynolds was also selected for the M55 English team at the home international and is still competitive at the top end of the M55 AG as he showed at the European Masters championships.

Ben Cole one of the leading athletes in the Senior men's team and running various TAC M35 records.

Neil McClements led the TAC Masters marathon times with a PB 2.28.37 at London We had a successful **Kent Vets XC champs** with 2 team golds, a silver and 2 bronze. Individual medals for Maria Heslop, Tina Oldershaw and Ben Reynolds. There were numerous TAC masters records broken.

Our W45 team were 3rd at the **BMAF road relays**, with the M35 team 6th on their debut We hosted a very successful **BMAF XC champs** at Somerhill in March, where we won M35 team and were runners up in the W35 and W45 team. Elle Baker was 2nd W35 and Ben Cole 3rd M35, Tina Oldersaw 3rd W45.

A very long story, but in a nutshell the UKA and EA have failed to give any satisfactory assurance that they have a policy / rules regarding the fairness of female sport regarding the inclusion of what we suspected was a trans runner in the women's race. We are seeking to avoid officials and individuals facing further issues at local and national level by clear leadership from the NGB's.

BMAF Masters Road Relays

Due to take place on 20th May at Sutton Coldfield. This year it is well after the marathons in April. Each athlete runs 5km. M35 is a team of 6, W35 and M45 teams of 4 and all other teams of 3. We can enter more than 1 team in each age group.

There are two divisions in both Men's and Women's leagues with promotion and relegation. There is some non scoring allowed.
